Where is Cabrillo Playground?

In the outer Richmond, just a few blocks away from Lafayette school. It is between 38th and 39th avenues, at Cabrillo Street, in the middle of the block.

Why should I care?

The playground is in our neighborhood. It is close to many schools and preschools and is used by the schoolchildren for outings and activities. The playground equipment was opened in 1928, last remodeled in the 1970's and has not been updated. The wood is splintering and the metal is rusting. The gates are too low and the park isn't locked at night, so frequently vandals destroy playground equipment, leave trash in the sandbox and broken bottles on the athletic field.
